### **RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS & CLUB MEMBERS**

By entering this trial, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the trial and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the Algoma Retriever Association and its Members and owner(s) of any property upon which the trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant how so ever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or his heirs, his executors and assigns.

### **NOTICE TO TRIALERS**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such actions as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Judges shall have the power to disqualify any dog which shall not appear within fifteen minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried, and to turn out of the stake any dog which does not obey its handler or any dog which they consider unfit to compete. Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn. The entry fees of all such dogs shall be forfeited except in the case of bitches in season.
