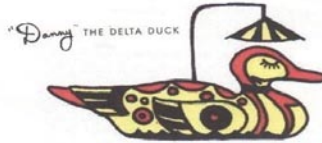

3. Entries **CLOSE** Monday, August 23, 2010.

4. The draw will take place at the residence of the Field Trial Secretary. **The starting dog number in the first series of the Open on Saturday and Sunday will be determined by using the last two digits at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index on the Thursday immediately preceding the trial . In All Age Stakes, a rotation will be used.**

5. A separate entry form for each dog in each stake is required. PLEASE USE THE OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS OR COPY OF SAME.

6. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry Fee (and, if applicable, Listing Fee and non-CKC member fee) in full. A listing fee of \$9.26 is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.

7. NO PHONE ENTRIES.

8. **Scratches** will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered a "scratch" refunds must be requested in writing to the Field Trial Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

DUCKS and PHEASANTS may be used in all stakes.

TROPHIES AND STANDARD CKC ROSETTES will be awarded for all placings in each stake. Standard CKC Rosettes will be for all CM's.

CAMPING AND TRAILER PARKING available. Electrical hook ups, no water. Fee \$5.00 per day payable to FT Secretary.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial-giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to all parties concerned. It shall also within ten days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of the report indicating that this rule has been violated.

DEFINITION OF STAKES

PUPPY	For dogs not over 1 year on the day of the trial
JUNIOR	For dogs not over 2 years on the day of the trial
QUALIFYING	For dogs who have never placed or had a certificate of merit in an Open All Stake, or placed in an Amateur All Age Stake, or won 5 Qualifying stakes
AMATEUR ALL AGE	For dogs over the age of 6 months and handled by an amateur as determined by the Field Trial Committee
OPEN ALL AGE	For dogs over the age of 6 months
