GAME: Ducks will be used in all tests.

AWARDS: Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to all dogs placing 1st 2nd 3rd 4th in all stakes. Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs in all stakes earning a Certificate of Merit.

RUNNING ORDER: Dogs and bitches will be mixed and ran in the order of the draw. Dogs handled by the same owner will be separated where possible. **It is the responsibility of the Handler to clarify any conflict with the Marshall of each test.**

NOTE: 1) Rotation: A System of Rotation will be implemented for All-age stakes Starting number will be based on the two digits right of the decimal on the prior Tuesday TSX closing
2) Judges can disqualify any dog, which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried.
3) Dogs will run in order unless excused by the marshal for that stake.
4) Bitches and dogs will run in the order drawn.
