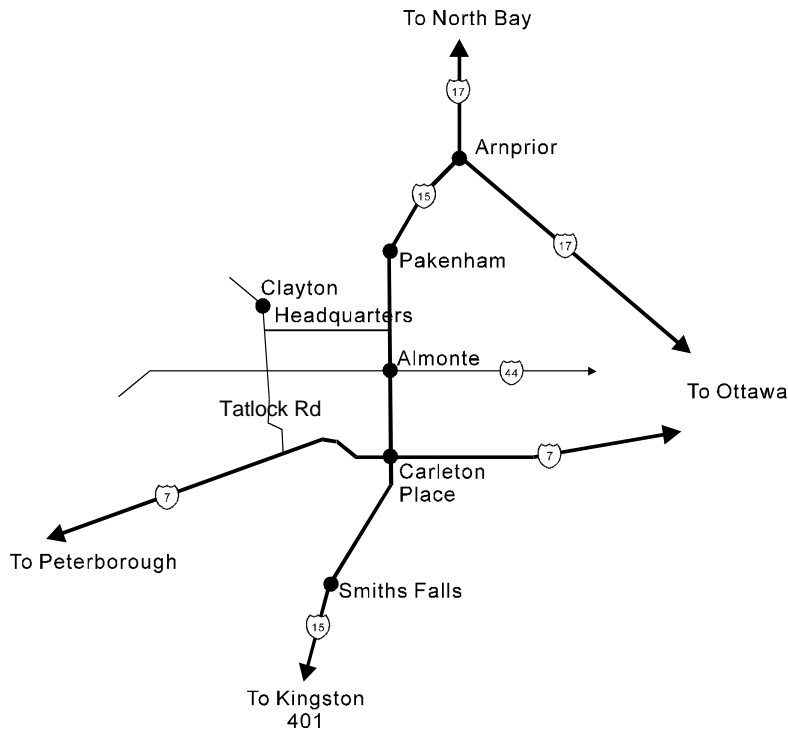

THESE EVENTS HELD UNDER THE RULES OF THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB

RULE 21.7 of the Retriever Field Trial Rules & Regulations states:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

RULE: 4.1.6 of the Field Trial Rules states: A Trial Secretary shall assume the responsibility of collecting all listing fees for the CKC, which shall be stated in the premium list.
