**GAME:** Ducks will be used in all tests.

**AWARDS:** Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to all dogs placing 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> in all stakes. Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs in all stakes earning a Certificate of Merit.

**RUNNING ORDER:** Dogs and bitches will be mixed and ran in the order of the draw. Dogs handled by the same owner will be separated where possible. **It is the responsibility of the Handler to clarify any conflict with the Marshall of each test.**

**NOTE:**

- 1) Rotation: A System of Rotation will be implemented for All-age stakes Starting number will be based on the two digits right of the decimal on the prior Thursday TSX closing
- 2) Judges can disqualify any dog, which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried.
- 3) Dogs will run in order unless excused by the marshal for that stake.
- 4) Bitches and dogs will run in the order drawn.

**Disciple Section 21.7 -Rules & Regulations for Retriever Field Trials 2011 states:** it shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a field trial held under these rules and regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

**Non-Member Participation Fee**

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be Charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a Choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards And titles to be canceled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to Dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."
