Dead ducks will be used.

Standard CKC ribbons will be awarded

Males and females will be run in the order of the draw. No bitches in season allowed

Any dog not appearing within 15 mins. of it's time to run may be disqualified

Rotation will occur in Open stake

Please do not litter the trial area. Take out more than you take in.

There will be no lunch wagon on site.

***No telephone entries will be accepted. Cheques must accompany entries. Hand deliver or use overnight postal deliveries if time is of the essence- send NO signature required. Send courier deliveries and hand deliver to 1589 Nurmi Rd, Merville, BC V0R 2M0***

CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until **6:00 pm Wednesday April 10/2013**. Entries must be accompanied by the full entry fee. Please send cheques payable to the Upper Island Retriever Club.

***US Cheques in Canadian funds will not be accepted...Cdn Money orders only***

A listing fee of \$8.56 must accompany each entry for those dogs not registered in Canada, or for those dogs whom do not hold an Event Registration number. A CKC Registration number or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the trial or all awards will be cancelled. Application forms available from CKC at the above address.

**Please note the new CKC ruling: Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.**

SCRATCH FEES: Bitches in estrus may not compete and must be withdrawn. Contestants must notify the F.T. Chairman of any scratch ***prior to start of stake***. Written requests for a refund will be given for dogs with-drawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death, when accompanied by a veterinarian certificate (less a scratch fee of \$10.00 per dog)

Starting dogs in the major stakes will be determined by the last two digits of the TSX closing on Monday April 15th, 2013 and will be based on the running order posted prior to commencement of the trial. A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the All-Age Stakes.

***LIABILITY: Please read the following carefully!***

**RELEASE & INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS**

By entering this trial, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the trial and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or her heirs, his executors and assigns.

**CKC Field Trial Rules and Regulations 5:2:2**

**\*\*Any person participating in any capacity at a field trial held under these rules, shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of this trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within ten (10) days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The discipline committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this rule has been violated.\*\***
