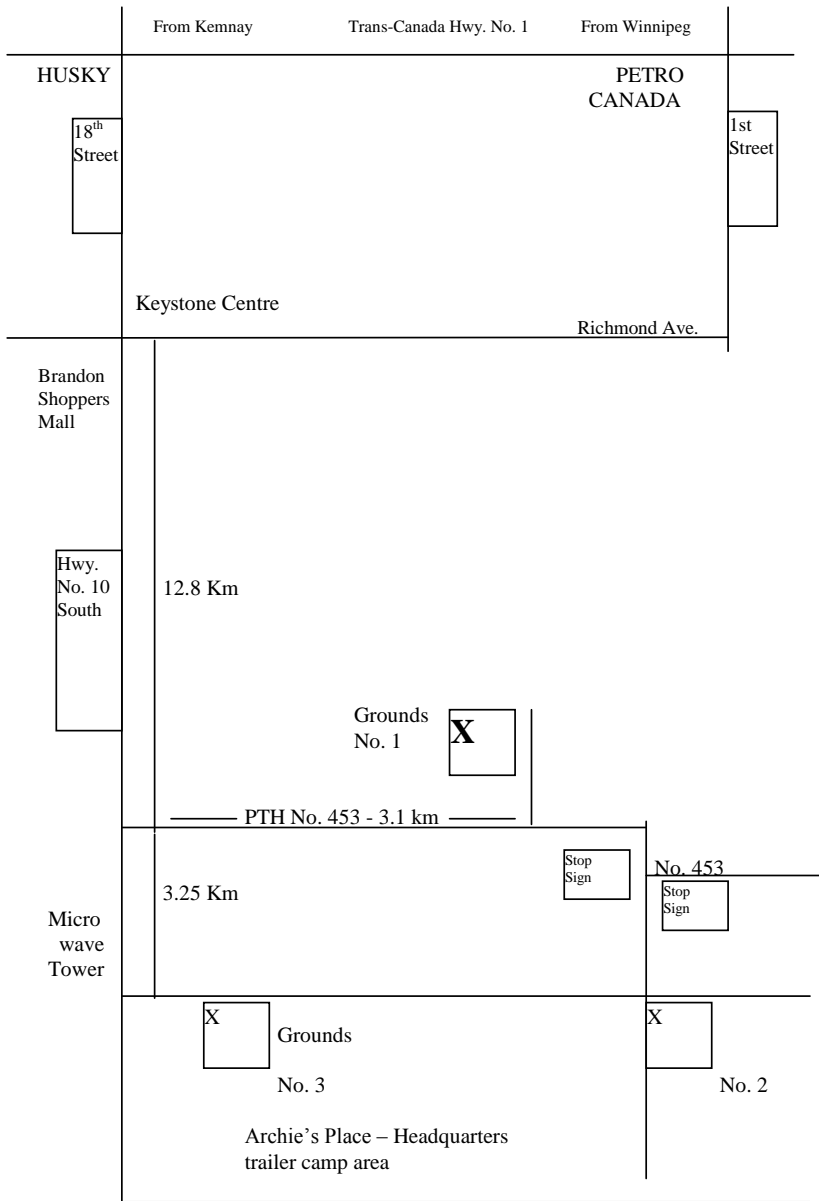

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial-giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind the field trial committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render a decision to all parties concerned. It shall also within ten days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of the report indicating that this rule has been violated.

Caution: The Brandon Retriever Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment as the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore, the Brandon Retriever Club will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to participants, bystanders, club members, workers or other individuals using the property for any purpose.

Release and indemnification of Landowners and the Brandon Retriever Club

By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with participation or entry upon the property. DEFINITION OF STAKES

PUPPY For dogs 6 months of age but not over 1 year on the day of the trial
JUNIOR For dogs not over 2 years on the day of the trial
QUALIFYING For dogs how have never won 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th or a certificate of merit in an Open All Age stake nor a 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th in an Amateur All Age Stake nor have won 5 Qualifyings
OPEN ALL AGE For dogs over 6 months of age
AMATEUR ALL AGE For dogs over 6 months if handled by a person deemed an Amateur by the Field Trial Committee
