Dead Ducks will be used in this trial. Males and females will run in order of the draw.

A system of rotation will be used for the start of the subsequent series in the All-Age Stakes.

Wingers may be used in all stakes.

Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC Licensed Trial.

Retriever Field Trial Rules & regulations of the Canadian kennel Club State In :

Section 21.7 Page 68

“ It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The retriever Filed Trial committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Section 3.3.2, page 7

“ Judges shall have the authority to disqualify any dog which does not appear within 15minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried.”
