Running Order: We will utilize the 2 ending digits in the TSX as of the close of business on Tuesday May 7, 2013 as a starting number for the first series in the all age stakes. Judges will impose a system of rotation thereafter in the all age stakes. Dogs will run in order of the draw with sexes mixed. Running order will rotate in the Open & Amateur stakes.
