Dead ducks will be used in this trial. Males and females will be run in order of the draw. A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the All-Age Stakes. Wingers may be used in all stakes. Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC Licensed Trial.

New CKC ruling: Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC.
