START TIMES AND CALLBACKS: for OPEN and AMATEUR stakes will be posted at the conclusion of each stake on Friday and Saturday evenings. **Judges will impose a system of ROTATION in BOTH the OPEN and AMATEUR stakes, using the 2 ending digits in the TSX as a starting number of the first series as of the close of business on Wednesday, June 18, 2014. Starting number will be posted on York Website yorkretrieverfieldtrialclub.ca and also Canadian Hunting Dog Forum.**

NEW C.K.C. Ruling – Beginning in 2011, an annual non-member participation fee for awards (placings) and titles will be charged to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure

to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards (points) and titles to be cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. CKC membership Application and Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the CKC website under CKC Services and then Forms on line.

The York Retriever Field Trial Club is a member of the National Retriever Club of Canada. Dogs entered in all-age stakes may qualify for the National Stake.

All entries must be received by the Draw party, **Monday, June 9, 7:00 PM** at the home of Dennis & Cheryl Ritchie. Cheques should be dated no later than June 9, 2012, and made payable to the York Retriever Field Trial Club in Canadian funds. U.S. currency will be accepted at par. LISTING FEE: The listing fee of \$9.50 per dog must be submitted for any dog not having an individual registration number.

Game Birds: Ducks will be used in all stakes

Prizes: Standard CKC Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs who place and to all C.M's. Presentations will be made at the completion of each stake at headquarters.

ALL SCRATCHES MUST BE REPORTED TO THE FIELD TRAIL SECRETARY 24 HOURS BEFORE THE TRIAL. Entry fees will be refunded only for bitches in season or for injured dogs, upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate. Once the catalogue has been printed, a \$10.00 surcharge will apply.

Notice to Trialer's: Chapter 20, Section 5 of the Field Trial Rules and Regulations states: Any person participating in any capacity at a Field Trial held under these rules shall not be subject to an indignity of any kind. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial giving Club of an alleged indignity of any kind the Field Committee of the Club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within ten days after its trial report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its finding. The Board of Directors of the CKC shall have the power to take such actions as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
