A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the All Age Stakes.

Wingers may be used in all stakes. Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC licensed Trial.

CKC Rules and Regulations 21.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever field Trial committee chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
