**ENTRIES: Please** complete **one entry form per dog, per stake** in which you wish to enter your dog(s). **All entries must contain complete information as required by the CKC rules and indicated on the up to date entry forms.**

All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full, and all listing fees(\$9.50 including HST) where applicable. A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual regulation is not shown on the entry form or ERN notices.

**Scratches:** entry fee refunded for a bitch in season when a vet certificate is produced; all other scratches will be refunded at the field trial committee's discretion, other than administration fee of \$10.00.

**RULE: 4.1.6** of the Field Trial Rules states: A Trial Secretary shall assume the responsibility of collecting all listing fees for the CKC, which shall be stated in the premium list.

The starting dog in the first series of Open And Amateur will be determined by using the last two digits at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (**TSE**) S&P/TSX composite index on the Thursday immediately preceding the trial. There will be a system of rotation for running order in all of the stakes at the Judges discretion.

**.NOTE: Rule 21.7** of the Field Trial Rules states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that a **Judge, Club Official, Volunteer or any Participant** at any event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the discipline committee shall have the Authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
