GAME BIRDS: Ducks or Pheasants may be used in all stakes.

PRIZES: CKC rosettes will be awarded to all dogs who place or are awarded a C.M.

HEADQUARTERS: Will be located at Simson Farm, 2 Firehall Lane, Parkinson Township, Ontario. From Hwy 17 in Iron Bridge, take Hwy 546 North approx. 10 km, Firehall Lane will be on your right at the curve, we are the first drive on the left. Signs will be up from the intersection of Hwy 17 & Hwy 546. Test sites will be well signed from major intersections in the area as well as from headquarters.

THERE WILL NOT BE FOOD AVAILABLE AT THIS TRIAL. THERE ARE RESTAURANTS IN IRON BRIDGE.
