*Excerpt from CKC Rules and Regulations for Field Trials: Sec21.7* - It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial- giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

The Niagara Peninsula Retriever Club is a member of the National Retriever Club of Canada. Dogs entered in All Age Stakes may qualify for the National Stakes.

**Running Order: We will utilize the 2 ending digits in the TSX as of the close of business on Wednesday, May 1, 2019 as a starting number for the first series in the All Age stakes. Judges will impose a system of rotation there after in the All Age Stakes. Running order will be rotated in the Open and Amateur stakes.**

**DIRECTIONS TO DANNY'S ESSO.** For Danny's Esso: Signs for each stake will be clearly visible from this corner.

From Toronto, take QEW to Niagara. Exit at Hwy. 406 to Welland., towards Niagara, then over the lift bridge to the stoplight at the intersection of Hwys. 20 & 58.

From U.S., take QEW to the Thorold Stone Rd. exit, towards Thorold. Turn left on Hwy.58. Continue to Hwy. 20.

Directions for the tailgate: Go south on Hwy. 58 from Danny's Esso towards Port Robinson. Go over the tracks and turn right at the flashing light. The road curves to the left past the fire hall. Then turn left on Cross St. to the Port Robinson Community Centre.
