ENTRIES: Please complete one entry form per dog, per stake, per day in which you wish to enter your dog(s). All entries must contain complete information as required by the CKC rules. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full. **Starting March 2nd, all owners of unregistered CKC recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) TCN's can be obtained by (a) Online through the CKC online portal** (note) Individuals who have not yet used the CKC Online Portal will be required to set up a Portal Account before they can submit a TCN Application.by submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC or

Prize list: standard CKC rosettes to the first four placings in each stake.

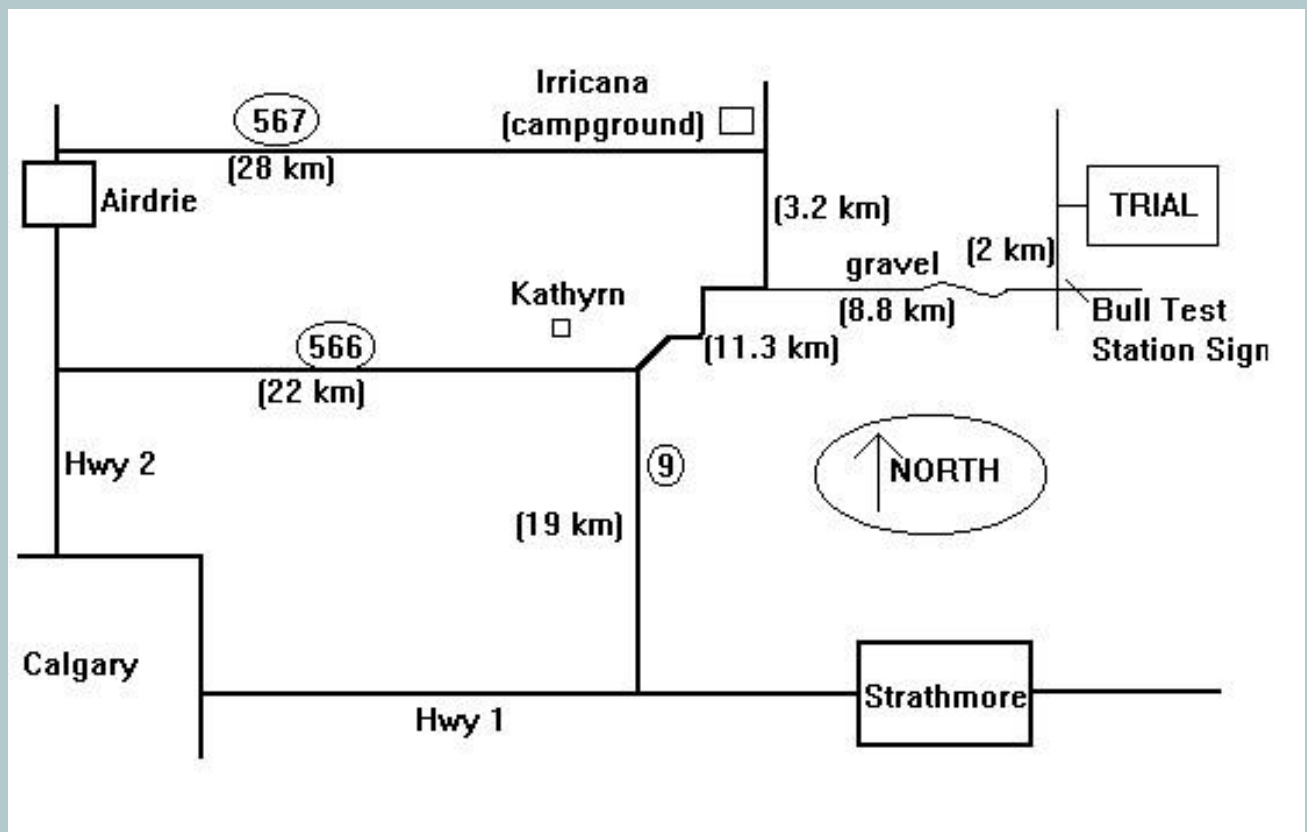
Certificates of Merit will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.

Retriever Field Trial Covid Guidelines

Please read the following guidelines which have been established to promote the health and safety of everyone during the current Covid situation. **It is assumed that by submitting an entry to the SCRC Field Trial, that you accept, agree and will abide by these guidelines. Remember we all play a key role in keeping ourselves safe. Social distancing must be maintained.**

1. It is incumbent on the Club and it's officers, Officials, participants and spectators to follow Guidelines applicable to the area, and Province in which the Field Trial is held.
2. Participants, Officials and Spectators must practice social distancing..... 6 feet between chairs.
3. Avoid shaking hands and hugging.
4. Avoid touching dogs or equipment that is Not your responsibility
5. Park with sufficient space / distance between your vehicles
6. Remain near your vehicle until just prior to running and follow the Marshall's instructions regarding running order and entering and exiting holding blinds. **The Gallery will be permitted at a location designated by the Marshall. Observers must practice social distancing and keep 6 feet apart at all times!**
7. Any special instructions from the Judges will be posted in the last holding blind.
8. Handlers may be invited to the line in small groups. It is possible, depending on your number, that you may not see the test dogs run from line. You will have the opportunity to see other dogs run from the holding blind, while waiting to run.
9. Anyone near or on the running line should maintain adequate distance from the handler as blowing a whistle could produce or project a vapour.
10. **Handlers must wear gloves while running their dog and taking birds.**
11. Judges are to bring their own equipment, judge books, etc where possible. Hand sanitizer will be available.
