At the end of the trial season, 100% of the funds collected will be distributed retroactively to the Host Club (s) for that year. This fee is included in your entry.

Non-Member Participation Fee (Effective January 1, 2011)
Policy:

Non-member participation fee

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

The fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Information:

- 🐾 A non member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.
- 🐾 There are 2 options for non-members:
 - a) Join the CKC
 - b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee
- 🐾 Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.
- 🐾 The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs or titles or awards earned and is assessed against the owner(s).
- 🐾 Non members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.
- 🐾 Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.
- 🐾 Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog.
- 🐾 Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.
- 🐾 The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated.

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

- 🐾 Refund of entry is subject to a veterinarians' certificate.
- 🐾 Dogs and bitches will be mixed and run in order of the draw
- 🐾 Dogs handled by the same person will be separated where possible

Excerpted from the Retriever Field Trial Rule Book

6.6.2 *The running order (the Draw) must be made and published (made public) prior to the date of the TSX closing number to determine the starting dog as per Section 6.6.3. Clubs holding the trial may not accept entries after the publishing of the running order.*

6.6.3 *In a stake carrying championship points the starting dog in the first series will be determined by using the last two digits at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index two days prior to the first day of the trial, or if the TSX is closed that day, the first day prior to that when the TSX is open*

(a) The starting dog will be the dog assigned the number in the draw that corresponds to the last two digits (including digits, if any to the right of the decimal point) of the closing S&P/TSX composite index (the TSX number) two days prior to the first day of the trial.

SWORTC is a member of the National Retriever Club of Canada and dogs placing in our CKC approved Licensed Trial will be eligible to compete in National Stakes.

A copy of the following rule shall be prominently placed in every Premium List:

"Any person participating in any capacity at a Field Trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial-giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within ten days after its trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its finding. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of the report indicating that this rule has been violated."

Furthermore, the South Western Ontario Retriever Training Club will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to participants, bystanders, club members, workers or any other individual using any of the properties for any purpose.

Field Trial Officials will be enforcing COVID -19 related guidelines whenever possible, however, The South Western Ontario Retriever Training Club will not be held responsible for transmission of the novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV2) and any related illness due to Covid-19.

ATTENTION: Please read and familiarize yourself with the following COVID-19 guidelines. The South Western Ontario Retriever Training Club will assume that by submitting your entry that you accept and will abide by all Ontario Provincial recommendations with regards to COVID-19.

1. Club officials and participants are required to follow all guidelines that apply.
2. Practice social distancing. Avoid congregating in groups as much as possible. Gallery must practice social distancing - 6 feet between chairs.
3. Avoid shaking hands and hugging.
4. Avoid touching dogs or equipment that does not belong to you or is not your responsibility.
5. Park with sufficient distance between vehicles.
6. Remain near your vehicle until just prior to running and follow the marshals instructions regarding running order and entering holding blinds.
7. Any special instructions from the judges will be posted in the holding blind.
8. Handlers will be invited to the line in small groups. You might not see the test dog run but will have the opportunity to see other dogs run from the holding blinds.
9. Gloves must be worn by handlers
10. Birds will be placed into a bucket or onto bird rack by the handler and dealt with by the marshal once the dog and handler leave the line.
11. Hand sanitizer will be available.
12. All handlers should bring their own radio as the marshal will use it to communicate when it is your turn to enter a holding blind and any other instructions. Tune your radio to channel 5 for marshal instructions.
13. Have fun, stay safe.
